Working with tables

Select all table borders or cell content, depending on initial selection	⌘	A

Paste the selection that was last copied	⌘	V
Delete selection (whole table, border or border segment, or contents of selected cells)	⌘	⌫

Manipulating fixed objects

Select all fixed objects	⌘	A	
Deselect all fixed objects	⌘	⇧	A
Send object to the back	⇧	⌘	B
Send object one layer back	⌘	⌫	B
Bring object to the front	⇧	⌘	F
Bring object one layer forward	⌘	⇧	F
Move object to section master	⌘	⌫	M
Group objects	⌘	⌫	G
Ungroup objects	⌘	⇧	G
Lock objects	⌘	L	
Unlock objects	⌘	⌫	L
Mask or unmask object	⌘	⇧	M
Exit mask mode	⌘	RETURN

Editing chart data

Show or hide Chart Data Editor	⇧	⌘	D
Complete a cell entry and move the selection down	⌘	RETURN	
Complete a cell entry and move the selection up	⇧	⌘	RETURN
Complete a cell entry and move the selection to the right	⌘	→	
Complete a cell entry and move the selection to the left	⇧	⌘	→
Delete the character to the left of the insertion point, or delete the selection	⌘	⌫	
Complete a cell entry and select the cell	⌘	↵	
Move to the beginning of the row	⌘	HOME	
Move to the last filled cell to the right in the current row	⌘	END	
Extend the selection to the beginning of the row	⇧	⌘	HOME
Extend the selection to the end of the row	⇧	⌘	END
