Regroup the selected objects	⌘ ⌘ J
Rotate the selected object clockwise	⌘ →
Rotate the selected object counterclockwise	⌘ ←
Format the selected object	⌘ ↑ 1
Duplicate selected objects	⌘ D
Resize selected objects	↑ ARROW KEYS

Presentations

Create a new presentation	⌘ N
Create a new presentation with a template from the PowerPoint Presentation gallery	⌘ ↑ P
Insert a new slide	⌘ ^ M OR COMMAND ↑ N
Zoom out	⌘ - (MINUS SIGN)
Zoom in	⌘ =
Make a copy of the selected slide	⌘ ↑ D
Open a presentation	⌘ O
Close a presentation	⌘ W
Print a presentation	⌘ P
Save a presentation	⌘ S
Save a presentation with a different name, location, or file format.	⌘ ↑ S
Quit PowerPoint	⌘ Q
Find text and formatting	⌘ F
Add a hyperlink to selected text, an image, or an object	⌘ K
Cancel a command, such as Save As	ESC
Undo an action	⌘ Z
Redo or repeat an action	⌘ Y

Switch to slide show ⌘ ↑ RETURN

Switch to full screen (hide menus) ⌘ ^ F

Switch to presenter view ⌘ ↵ RETURN

Show or hide guides ⌘ ↵ ^ G

Switch to notes master view ⌘ ↵ 3

Selecting text

To Select One character to the right ↑ →

To Select One character to the left ↑ ←

To Select From the insertion point to the same point one line up ↑ ↑

To Select From the insertion point to the same point one line down ↑ ↓

To Select All text to the start of the line ⌘ ↑ ←

To Select All text to the end of the line ⌘ ↑ →

To Select From the insertion point to the end of the paragraph ↑ ↵ ↓

To Select From the insertion point to the beginning of the paragraph ↑ ↵ ↑

Slide shows

(OR CLICK THE MOUSE BUTTON)

PAGE UP , ← , ↑ , OR DELETE

VIEW, AND THEN PRESS RETURN

Display a black screen, or return to the slide show from a black screen B OR .

Display a white screen, or return to the slide show from a white screen W OR ,

Play slide show from the first slide ⌘ ↑ RETURN

Play slide show from the current slide ⌘ RETURN

OR COMMAND . OR COMMAND -

Erase on-screen annotations E

Go to next hidden slide if the next slide is hidden H

Redisplay hidden pointer and/or change the pointer to a pen ⌘ P

Redisplay hidden pointer and/or change the pointer to an arrow ⌘ A

Hide the pointer on mouse move ^ H

Show Thesaurus entry for a selected word ⌘ ↵ ^ R

Show Smart Lookup entry for a selected word or phrase ⌘ ↵ ^ L

Switch to presenter view ⌘ RETURN

Working in tables

Move to the next cell →

Move to the preceding cell ↑ →

Move to the next line or row ↓

Move to the preceding line or row ↑

Start a new paragraph in a cell RETURN

3 AT THE END OF THE LAST ROW

Windows and dialog boxes

Close the active window ⌘ W

Perform the action assigned to a default button in a dialog box RETURN

Cancel a command and close the dialog box ESC

Hide the current window ⌘ H

Minimize the current window ⌘ M
